On July 23, 2007, a group of 25 Kanata cyclists organized by Eric Kunstadt have joined Tim in Smith Falls and accompanied him to CHEO and then to the Parliament, ending the day at the Sensplex in Kanata.



The riders met at 5:45 am at the Kunstadt Sports' Kanata store to be able to start in Smith Falls at 8:00 am. Two Kunstadt Sports vans accompanied the tour, one driven by Mike Plummer for service and repairs and one driven by Susan Kunstadt, to assist riders with their personal items.

On his stop at CHEO, Tim spent an hour and a half talking to young leukemia patients, giving them hope and showing them that they can be cured just like him.
